What?: Communities In Schools exists to surround students with a community of support, empowering them to stay in school and achieve in life. Our volunteers support students through tutoring and mentorship services as well as a variety of special events.

Why?: Communities In Schools is the largest drop-out prevention nonprofit in the U.S. You can get experience with children/in a class room while earning service hours which can make you eligible for various scholarships and awards. Baldwin County students desperately need your help to reach their best potential.

Who?: Communities In Schools has a Site Coordinator in all of the local Baldwin County schools, who identifies students who are at risk of dropping out. CIS partners with local community agencies to provide the student with services (health care, tutoring, clothing, etc.) that they may need to be successful in the classroom.

Where?: CIS currently serves at The Early Learning Center, Lakeview Primary School, Midway Hills Primary, Lakeview Academy, Midway Hills Academy, Oak Hill Middle School, Baldwin High School, and Georgia College Early College.

When?: We only ask that volunteers commit one hour per week. If you like it, you can serve more! We have set times in each school, so after contacting us to get involved we will get you connected to the school that best meets your scheduling needs.

How?: Register at the GIVE Center on campus. After completing their orientation process at the GIVE Center, you will be contacted by CIS to begin your CIS orientation process, and you will be placed in a school. The Site Coordinator at the school will then place you with a student(s).
